

Once called Trinacria (the island with 3 points), Sicily is an island since 600'000 years, during which time it was torn from the Italian boot by violent earthquakes. Land of mystery, it is of incomparable beauty, endowed with a vast cultural heritage. Sicily is the largest island of the Mediterranean with about 1,000 km of coastline. It is also the point to meet many cultures, which earned him to have forged a atmosphere of its own. Under the same bright sun, we find ourselves fabulous Greek ruins, cathedrals and Norman castles, of Arab gardens, palaces and churches in the Hispanic Baroque. Sicily, it's also a particular art of living, an offbeat way to see the things, sometimes quite confusing for a stranger. A deep soul and secret..

Sicily is an autonomous region of Italy. Besides Italian which is the language official, most of the inhabitants also speak Sicilian, the original language latin with Arab, Germanic, Spanish, French and Italian.

### Practical information

#### Formalities

#### Geography

Sicily seems geographically marked by the number 3... 3 points, hence its shape triangular, 3 main mountains, 3 historical regions called valleys to time of the Arabs and 3 km separating the south of the Italian boot and the island by the strait of Messina.

To the southwest, Africa and notably Tunisia are a few hours away of the boat. The interior of the country offers a face both arid, desolate and green. The landscape y represents a kind of petrified sea, without any coherence, born from a delusion of creation. The main mountain massif, the Appenino Siculo, peaks at 1,979 m and stretches for nearly 200 km along the coast north. The hills of western Sicily, sometimes clayey, sometimes limestone, sometimes rich in plaster, contrast radically with the plains. The plain of Catania is particularly rich and fertile. Very extensive, it is full of olive trees, vineyards and fields of wheat.



### Good to know

#### The Aeolian Islands

The Aeolian archipelago is part of the Sicily. Located north of the Gulf of Milazzo, it is one of the most spectacular archipelagos to the world. These seven small islands were born of volcanoes, some of which are still in activity: Vulcano and Stromboli. These two islands are the most frequented with that of Lipari. The black sand beaches, the mountains of pumice stone and the flows of obsidian bring together again an amazing mix from the forces of nature. All the islands are from easy access by ferries or hydrofoils to the departure from Palermo, Cefalù or Messina

#### The volcanoes

The east of the island is marked by two large volcanic formations: Etna to the north and the Iblei Mountains to the south. Etna, with an altitude of 3 323 m, is one of the highest volcanoes in Europe and also one of the most active of the world. Very capricious (135 eruptions since the antiquity), he is regularly talked about. Etna's eruptions make it the main geological attraction of Sicily. The landscape del'Etna is magnificent. There are some snow for seven months. Its slopes are covered with almond, hazelnut and pistachio trees. Below are orchards, vineyards, banana trees, palm trees, of fig trees and eucalyptus trees. The wildlife y is extremely diverse. The road network (national, departmental, communal, paths of the regional forest

body, trails) offers many solutions to face the activity towards the volcano, or even for accomplish nice experiences in the woods.

#### The craft

In Sicily, products from crafts are wooden pupi puppets, some ceramics, wrought iron objects and of lace. Sicily is an important testimony of ceramic production artisanal, it is the cradle of civilization from the Mediterranean area. The first ceramics date from prehistory.

#### Gastronomy

Sicilian cuisine is mixed and has subtly integrated the contributions of all the civilizations that she has seen succeed each other. On the coasts, fish and mollusks are kings: sardines, tuna, swordfish, calamars and octopuses. Inland, the products from the terroir are tasty: lamb, delicatessen and especially the eggplant of which Sicily cannot pass. We prepare it gratinated, stuffed or as a side dish with the pasta. A of the specialties of the island is La Caponata, a cold ratatouille. Sicily begins also to produce more and more wines reputed: coming mainly from the Inzolia and Catarrato grape varieties. The slopes of Etna produce a dry white wine and a wine red, the Cerasuolo, with a cherry taste of more refined. The Muscat of Pantelleria is a sweet wine of the most appreciated just like the Malvasia of the island of Salina with the

liqueur Amaro Averna and the Limoncello.

#### Sports and leisure

The clear and limpid water and the seabed volcanics of the Aeolian Islands are a paradise for divers, the reserve marine del' d'Ustica as the funds of the îles Favignana, Pantelleria and Lampedusa deserve underwater explorations. It's off the coast of Taormina that the movie The Great Blue has been turned. The hike, indoors of the island, is mainly done in parks naturals of Madonie, Nebrodi and Peloritani. Moreover, the Etna natural park is the setting ideal for magnificent baladas and the coastal trails of the natural reserve of the Zingaro are perfect for enjoying the air of the sea. The nautical clubs know a strong development and the rental of material is easy from your boat location with a motor to go around the islands and exploring the caves. The Aeolian Islands, all like the côtesud, are very appreciated by the windsurfers and sailing enthusiasts for their winds. Horseback riding is mainly practiced in the natural reserve of Ciane and in Pantalica, where ranches offer to superb horse rides in the hinterland syracusain.
